## General

1. There were very few 3gun shoots on the calendar, and it was general felt that members were too lazy to get involved in the preparation for such an event, which requires considerable effort; DMG was a lot more work. Adrian Rosslee was happy to organize more such shoots, but needed assistance. Francois de Klerk (JDPC) stated 3 gun shoots were dependent on time constraints and range availability. It was agreed to employ workers to assist at these events, as necessary.
2. Adrian Rosslee advised that the Expo at Ellisras, was about to accredit which would start drawing members away from IDPA. Criteria : having participated in two 3gun shoots.
3. Nigel Hulleman felt it would be difficult to force clubs to host such events, but clubs should at least host 1 Classifier, 1 League and 1 3Gun. Club accreditation should be annulled if they did not comply with these minimum requirements; NvdNest stated that most clubs did comply.
4. Adrian Rosslee suggested smaller clubs join forces to host a league, which would split the cost, work and results.
5. It should be made compulsory for Clubs with more than 20 members to host 3gun shoots.
6. It was again reiterated that SADPA would assist clubs financially with equipment, especially new clubs.

Nicholas van der Nest concluded the AGM at 10:30am and thanked members for their participation and attendance.

## **SADPA AGM, March 2011**

### **Feedback – Administration Portfolio**

- Website and database was up and running throughout without any significant outages.
- Normal maintenance has been done, calendar has been kept up to date and some rearrangement of the content has been done. Would have liked to do more such as online entry for leagues, new photos etc, but all in due course.
- There were one or two backlogs, but in general database was kept up to date.

#### STATS

- In the last year 16 Feb to 15 Feb, we loaded a total of 192 shoots vs 183 of previous year, attended by 599 (508) shooters, who attended an average of 6 shoots per person per year, for a total of about 3,560 attendances. Most active was Hans Joubert with 26 shoots.
- For the current Calendar year we have almost 200 shoots scheduled for 2010.

#### DSS

- 2011 DSS points update was done timeously and the DSS list as at end of Dec 2010 was forwarded to CFR. We had about 330 DS with about 20 lapsing last year. Rules will be enforced stricter going forward.

#### POSTAL Shoot

- Postal shoot attendance successful with 280 participants to date. Results will be available in next two weeks.

#### WAY FORWARD

- We're still encountering issues with incorrect classifications as members still don't understand the rules associated.
