4.4 Matches & Competitions

African champs

Novices can apply and must prove that their safety skills are up to standards.
This application must be accompanied by a letter of endorsement from the club chairman.

FdeK to send this out requirement out on SADPA Groups, something like "As is an international match and due to safety concerns, a novice shooter must get endorsement from the club chairman." FdeK

IDPA sanctioning

Has been received from IDPA.

Criteria van participation in African Champs

Paid up SADPA member
Must have shot one league
Must have shot one classifier in the participating division
All shoots to have take place from nationals to nationals.

With the champs debriefing rules must be obtained in order to make the next champs easier.

Scorebook for champs

Approved by the Exco. RZ to finalise.

Classifiers

It is felt that not enough classifiers are being shot. An option might be that a club can host a classifier as part of a normal club shoot, and the shooter must book a spot in the classifier.

DS gives the proposal that all documentation must be shipped to admin@sadpa.co.za, RZ then to distribute.

Club affiliation

Clubs must be made aware of the requirements to remain a SADPA affiliated club. FdeK

4.5 Safety & Training

NSO program

Has been developed, must now be implemented.

All shooters who joined after 1 July 2004 must undergo the program, as well as all other shooters identified by club chairmen. FdeK to inform all shooters on SADPA_groups Fdek

SO training

SO training on the new rulebook will happen with the SO clinics. The Director Safety and Training has the right to relieve a SO of his/her duties.

The level of SO Training must be standardised.

If a SO has to make a call and in communicating this to the shooter, it must be done in a diplomatic manner.

SO Training schedule

SO Orientation clinic – 8 May 2005

Level II – 21 May 2005 – All SO's that missed the SO Orientation must attend.

Level I – 25 June 2005

Level II – 26 June 2005

Cape Town – 11 and 12 June 2005. To include Touwsrivier

George – 13 June 2005 (SO Orientation)

Level 1 – 15 or 16 June 2005 for Free State clubs

AvT to be compensated at AA tariffs. Clubs to pay for this.
